The Nevada Blind Children's Foundation ("NBCF") provides the essential building blocks including extended educational curriculum, extracurricular activities, social opportunities, and transitional skills to children who are visually impaired.

NBCF provided services and support to 91 blind/visually impaired children and their families during the 2018-2019 school year. Programs and services focused on three key goals: increase high school graduation, increase employment for blind adults, and the quality of life for all blind/visually impaired children. To move students toward each of these goals, NBCF provides a comprehensive approach offering afterschool and weekend programs that are educational and fun. Programs include: Afterschool Tutoring (braille, blind specific technology, and core subjects), S.T.E.A.M. (Science, Technology, Engineering, Art, Math), Competitive Lego Robotics Teams, What's Cooking Class, Horsin' Around Adaptive Sports, Booktime Buddies Literacy Skills, Sensory Play, and Occupational Therapy. Programs in partnership with Touro University.

Blind Specific Physical Activities and Special Events - NBCF provides the only blind specific day camp in Nevada, accredited by the American Camping Association. In addition, NBCF provides adaptive sports and recreation programs such as Beep Baseball, Kickball, Goal Ball, and Power Showdown. In addition, NBCF provides special events that incorporate the whole family, providing specialized equipment and resources necessary for everybody to enjoy. These events include: Beeping Egg Hunt, Holiday Party, and Fun Friday's for blind and visually impaired children and their sighted siblings.

Family Support & Education - NBCF's Family Advocate provides individualized support to children with visual impairments and their families, including: support booking medical appointments and engaging with medical professionals, guidance on how to maximize insurance and/or Medicaid benefits, support and education on issues specific to their medical/visual impairment, and connections to community resources to support their needs. In addition to the work of NBCF's Family Advocate, the organization provides education programs for individuals with visual impairments and their families.
